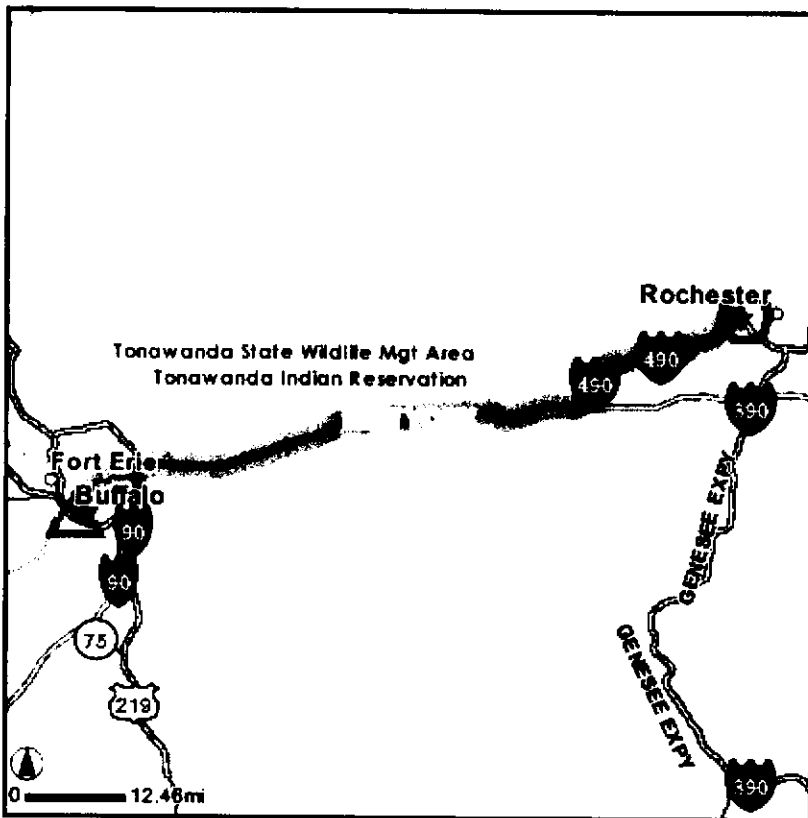

1. Start out heading SOUTH on PEARL STREET towards W MOHAWK STREET. Drive for 0.1 miles.
2. Turn LEFT onto COURT STREET. Drive for 0.1 miles.
3. Go STRAIGHT on CLINTON STREET. Drive for 0.2 miles.
4. Turn LEFT onto ELM STREET. Drive for 0.5 miles.
5. Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto RT-33 E. Drive for 6.8 miles.
6. Take I-90 E towards THRUWAY / I-90 E / ALBANY / I-290. Drive for 42.8 miles.
7. Take exit number 47 to get on I-490 E towards I-490 / LEROY / RT-19 / ROCHESTER. Drive for 16.8 miles.
8. Take exit number 7A towards RT-33 E / GATES CENTER. Drive for 0.4 miles.
9. Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto BUFFALO ROAD.
10. Drive for 2.1 miles to reach the destination.
