

SANITARIAN VI, REGISTERED (0321)

(The current vacancy is the Section Head of the Center for Food Processing with the Infectious Disease and Environmental Health Administration, Baltimore, MD.)

This position will serve as the Section Head, for the Western Region, Center for Food Processing. The incumbent will manage food processing plant inspection programs which ensures compliance with State and federal laws, regulations and standards in order to promote public health and allow the free flow of Maryland food products into intrastate and interstate commerce. This position will supervise environmental sanitarians who conduct on-site inspections of food processing plants within the state, as well as manage the contracted FDA inspection program. The Section Head provides guidance to OFPCHS and local health department staff in the interpretation of State and Federal laws and regulations. As a member of the OFPCHS, the section Head is an Emergency Responder and subject to be called to respond to natural and man-made public health emergencies on any day at any time necessary. must possess a current license as a Registered Environmental Sanitarian from the Maryland State Board of Environmental Sanitarians and Six years of environmental health work experience in the promotion, control, and maintenance of environmental health, two years of which must have involved direction of an environmental control project and/or supervision of positions performing environmental health work.
