TITLE: SANITARIAN IV, REGISTERED (0277) CD
(Current vacancy as a Plan Review Specialist at the Infectious Disease and Environmental Health Administration (IDEHA), Baltimore, Maryland)

DESCRIPTION: This position will act as a Plan Review Specialist for the Center for Retail Food, Facility, and Process Review Unit. This position will coordinate a statewide program that provides for the review and approval of plans for new remodeling food establishments and ensures inspection of these facilities to determine compliance with State and Federal law, regulations, and standards in order to promote public health. The coordinated programs provide leadership, oversight, and training with the food industry and other regulatory agencies. The incumbent provides consultation on food regulatory issues, plan review, food equipment, and licensing to private citizens, industry, local health departments, and agencies outside the department. Also, the incumbent may be required to perform food processing plant inspections.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

EXPERIENCE: Four years of environmental health work experience in the promotion, control, and maintenance of environmental health, two years of which must have involved direction of an environmental control project and/or the supervision of positions performing environmental health work.

LICENSE: Applicants must be currently licensed as a Registered Environmental Sanitarian with the Maryland State Board of Environmental Sanitarian Registration. A photocopy of current license MUST be attached to the application form (MS-100).

NOTES:

1. Applicants may substitute a master's degree in public health or environmental health sciences for one year of the required general experience.

2. Licensure requirements are pursuant to Title 11 of the Environment Article, Annotated Code of Maryland. The Secretary of Budget and Management cannot accept any substitutions.

3. Further information on eligibility requirements, including license application procedures, may be obtained from the Administrative Officer, State Board of Environmental Sanitarians, 1800 Washington Blvd; Baltimore MD 21230.
